1.1 References:

References to the Act are to the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets (PPDPA) Act [Chapter 22:23] and references to the regulations are to the PPDPA (General) Regulations (Statutory Instrument No. 5 of 2018). The terms and requirements in the Act and Regulations govern the submission of bids and should be read by all Bidders.

In line with section 14 of the PPDPA Act [Chapter 22:23] No. 5 of 2017 as read in conjunction with section 10(3) |a| and schedule 2 (section 8 (5)(a) of the PPDPA (General) Regulations (Statutory Instrument No. 5 of 2018), the Airports Company of Zimbabwe (Private) Limited (ACZ) is inviting bids from reputable and experienced companies for the Supply and Delivery of Mobile Cellphones.

In compliance with section 27(1) and (2) of the PPDPA Act, the ACZ has detailed the specifications of its procurement requirements for the Supply and Delivery of Mobile Cellphanes as contained in clause 2.3 of the bidding document. The evaluation of the bids to be received for this tender shall be done in compliance with section 4(1) of the PPDPA Act to ensure the achievement of transparency, fairness, honesty, competition among Bidders, fair and equitable treatment of all Bidders, promotion of integrity, achievement of environmental, social, and economic requirements of the procurement law.

The successful Bidder will be required to enter into a contract with ACZ which will conform to the requirements of sections 78 to 89 of the PPDPA Act.

1.8 Validity of Bids

1.13 Bid Prices and Discounts

1.15 Review by the Special Procurement Oversight Committee

This contract is not subject to review by the Special Procurement Oversight Committee (SPOC).

1.16 Evaluation of Bids

Bids will be evaluated using the following methodology:

- Preliminary examination to confirm that all documents required have been provided, to confirm the eligibility of Bidders in terms of section 28 (1) of the Regulations and to confirm that the bid is administratively compliant in terms of section 28 (2) of the Regulations.
- Technical evaluation to determine substantial responsiveness to the specifications in the statement of requirements.
- Submission of colour catalogue and brochure is mandatory.
- Financial evaluation and comparison to determine the evaluated price of bids and to determine the lowest evaluated bid.
- Vendor support, warranty of the products and availability of technical assistance clearly articulated.

1.17 Evaluation Criteria

The ACZ's evaluation of bids will consider, in addition to the bid price, the following criteria.

- (a) Delivery schedule: The specified goods are required to be delivered by the date indicated in the delivery schedule in Part 2. Preference will be given to bids offering delivery within the stipulated time.
- (b) Deviation in payment schedule: The payment schedule is stated in the Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) in Part 3. A bidder may propose a deviation from the schedule and if the deviation is considered acceptable to ACZ, the bid will be evaluated by calculating interest earned for any earlier payments involved in the terms outlined in the bid as compared with those stipulated in the SCC, at the rate of interest indicated by the Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe (RBZ) on the closing date for submission of bids.

1.22 Award of Contract

The lowest evaluated bid per item, after application of any additional evaluation criteria, including any margin of preference, which is substantially responsive to the requirements of this bidding document, will be recommended for award of contract. The proposed award of contract will be by issue of a notification of contract award in terms of section 55 of the Act which will be effective until signing.

1.23 Right to Reject

The ACI reserves the right to accept or reject any bids or to cancel the procurement process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award.

1.24 Corrupt Practices

The Government of Zimbabwe requires that procuring entities, as well as Bidders and contractors observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of contracts. In pursuit of this policy:

- The ACZ will reject a recommendation for award if it determines that the Bidder recommended for award has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the contract or been declared ineligible to be awarded a procurement contract under section 99 of the Act.
- The PRAZ may under section 72 (6) of the act impose the sanctions under section 74 (1) of the Regulations; and
- Any conflict of interest on the part of the Bidder must be declared.
