PART 1: BIDDING PROCEDURES

1.1 References:

References are to the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets (PPDPA) Act [Chapter 22:23] and to the PPDPA (General) Regulations (Statutory Instrument No. 5 of 2018). The terms and requirements in the Act and Regulations govern the submission of bids and should be read by all Bidders.

In line with section 14 of the PPDPA [Chapter 22:23] No. 5 of 2017 as read in conjunction with section 10(3) (a) and schedule 2 (section 8 (5)(a)) of the (General) Regulations (Statutory Instrument No. 5 of 2018). The Airports Company of Zimbabwe (Private) Limited (ACZ) is inviting bids from reputable and experienced companies to participate in the tender for the Supply and Delivery of Uninterrupted Power Supply Units (UPS).

In compliance with section 27(1) and (2) of the PPDPA Act, the ACZ has detailed the specifications of its procurement requirements for the **Uninterrupted Power Supply Units** contained in clause 2.3 of the bidding document. The evaluation of the bids to be received for this tender shall be done in compliance with section 4(1) of the PPDPA Act to ensure the achievement of transparency, fairness, honesty, competition among Bidders, fair and equitable treatment of all Bidders, promotion of integrity, achievement of environmental, social and economic requirements of the procurement law.

The successful Bidder will be required to enter into a contract with ACZ which will conform to the requirements of sections 78 to 89 of the PPDPA Act.

The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction. All pages of the bid must be clearly marked with the procurement reference number above and the Bidder's name and reference number.

1.4 Lots and Packages

This procurement requirement shall not be divided into lots or packages.

1.5 Number of bids allowed

No Bidder may submit more than one (1) bid, either individually or as a joint venture partner in another bid, except as a subcontractor. Where the procurement is divided into lots and packages, only one (1) bid can be submitted. A conflict of interest will be deemed to arise if bids are received from more than one (1) Bidder owned, directly or indirectly, by the same person.

1.7 Pre-bid meeting

There shall be no pre-bid meeting for this procurement requirement.

1.8 Validity of Bids

The minimum period that the Bidder's bid must remain valid is at least 60 days from the deadline for the submission of bids.

1.9 Eligibility and Qualification Criteria

Bidders are required to meet the criteria in section 28 of the Act to be eligible to participate in public procurement and to be qualified for the proposed contract. They must therefore, provide any available documentation and certify their eligibility in the Bid Submission Sheet. To be eligible:

- e) Bidders must attach at least three (3) references on client's letter heads where the Bidder supplied jerseys and /or shoes.
- F) Participation in this bidding procedure is open to Domestic Bidders.
- g) Proof of payment of Bid Security.
- h) Bidders must state the warranty period.

1.10 Submission of Bids

Bids must be submitted in writing in a sealed envelope to the address below, no later than the date and time of the deadline below. It is the Bidder's responsibility to ensure that they receive a receipt confirming submission of their bid that has correct details of the Bidder and the number of the bid.

The Bidder must mark the envelope with the Bidder's name and address and the procurement reference number.

1.11 Bid opening

Bidders and their representatives may witness the opening of bids, which will take place at the submission address immediately following the deadline.

1.11 Withdrawal, amendment or modification of Bids

A Bidder may withdraw, substitute, or modify its bid after it has been submitted by sending a written notice, duly signed by an authorized representative. However, no Bid may be withdrawn, substituted, or modified in the interval between the deadline for submission of Bids and the expiration of the period of Bid validity specified by the Bidder or any extension of that period.

1.12 Delivery Requirements

The delivery period required (from the date of contract signing) and the final destination for delivery are as indicated in the Delivery Schedule in Part 2.

1.13 Bid Prices and Discounts

(c) Bidders must clearly state their payment terms. Payment is strictly after goods have been delivered.

1.14 Bid Security

1.15 Evaluation of Bids

Bids will be evaluated using the following methodology:

- Preliminary examination to confirm that all documents required have been provided, to confirm the eligibility of Bidders in terms of section 28 (1) of the Regulations and to confirm that the Bid is administratively compliant in terms of section 28 (2) of the Regulations.

3. Financial evaluation and comparison to determine the evaluated price of bids and to determine the lowest priced bid.

4. Vendor support and warranty of the products, customer support, responsiveness, availability of technical assistance clearly articulated.

Bids failing at any stage will be eliminated and will not be considered in subsequent stages.

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1.16 Review by the Special Procurement Oversight Committee

This tender procurement requirement will not be subject to review by the Special Oversight Committee (SPOC).

1.17 Eligibility and Qualification Criteria

Bidders are required to meet the criteria in section 28 of the Act to be eligible to participate in public procurement and to be qualified for the proposed contract. They must, therefore, provide any available documentation and certify their eligibility in the bid submission sheet. To be eligible, Bidders must;

- 4. Not be debarred from participation in public procurement under section 72 (6) of the Act and section 74(1) (c), (d) or (e) of the Regulations or declared ineligible under section 99 of the Act; attach current copy of registration or renewal of registration with PRAZ.
- Have been registered with the PRAZ as a Supplier and have paid the applicable Supplier Registration Fee set out in Part III of the Fifth Schedule to the Regulations; attach current copy of registration or renewal of registration with PRAZ.

1.18 Evaluation Criteria

The ACZ's evaluation of bids will consider, in addition to the bid price, the following criteria.

- (a) Delivery schedule: The specified goods are required to be delivered by the date indicated in the delivery schedule in Part 2. Preference will be given to bids offering delivery within the stipulated time.
- (b) Deviation in payment schedule: The payment schedule is stated in the Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) in Part 3. A bidder may propose a deviation from

1.19 Origin of Goods

All goods and related services must have their country of origin as an eligible country, as specified in the SCC.

1.20 Technical Criteria

The technical specifications sheet details the minimum specification of the Supply and Delivery of Uninterrupted Power Supply Units. The goods offered must meet this specification, but no credit will be given for exceeding the specification.

1.21 Currency

Bids must be priced in both United States Dollars (US\$) and Zimbabwe Dollars (ZW\$) in line with \$.1185 of 2020. The currency of evaluation will be US dollars. Payment for domestic (local) Bidders will be in Zimbabwe dollars at the prevailing RBZ foreign currency bank rate.

1.22 Award of Contract

The lowest priced bid, after application of any additional evaluation criteria, including any margin of preference, which is substantially responsive to the requirements of this bidding document, will be recommended for award of contract. The proposed award of contract will be by issue of a Notification of Contract Award in terms of section 55 of the Act which will be effective until signature of the contract documents in accordance with Part 3: Contract. Unsuccessful Bidders will receive the Notification of Contract Award and, if they consider they have suffered prejudice from the process, they may within 14 days of

The ACZ reserves the right to accept or reject any Bids or to cancel the procurement process and reject all Bids at any time prior to contract award.

1.24 Corrupt Practices

The Government of Zimbabwe requires that Procuring Entities, as well as Bidders and Contractors, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of contracts. In pursuit of this policy;

- The ACZ will reject a recommendation for award if it determines that the Bidder recommended for award has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the Contract or been declared ineligible to be awarded a procurement contract under section 99 of the Act;
- The PRAZ may under section 72 (6) of the Act impose the sanctions under section 74 (1) of the Regulations; and
- Any conflict of interest on the part of the Bidder must be declared.


